How did God speak to you through Sunday's worship and the message of Rev 3:14-22?

MAIN POINT: Let Me IN

1. What do you think is the meaning of the words hot, cold, and lukewarm?
2. The church of Laodicea, like the city, is negatively characterized as pridefully independent and self-sufficient. How are these traits negative?
3. When a Christian becomes Laodicean, it's equivalent to Paul's expression of "living in the flesh" (1Cor 2) which is powered by human drives and not the Spirit-filled and empowered life. Talk about how we as Christians can avoid this and steps to correct it.
4. What tips would you give to correct or encourage a Christian that describes their walk with Christ as dry and uninspired. How can we keep our faith and dependence on Christ fresh and growing?
5. Revelation 3:20 means something quite different within the message to the church of Laodicea, than its frequent use within evangelism. Was this new to you?
6. How do you "Let Christ In" on a daily basis?
