MAIN POINT: Love wins, when Jesus is Lord

1. If a Christian friend was discouraged with his or her own marriage, how would you use Ephesians 5:21-33 to encourage the friend if he is the husband? And how would you use this passage if the friend is the wife?
2. Who has the greater responsibility in a Christian marriage? How would you support your answer from verses 22-33?
3. Define the husband's relationship (responsibility) to his wife based on Ephesians 5:21-33?
4. Define the wife's relationship (responsibility) to her husband based on Ephesians 5:21-33?

5. Read Ephesians 5:1-2 and 5:21. Discuss this statement: "Submission isn't just for wives, sacrificial love isn't just for husbands."
6. Read Ephesians 5:25-30 and note the words of v28, "in the same way husbands." What do these verses tell us about Christ's love for us and a husband's love for his wife?
