

Timely Truths: Sobering Sayings of Jesus
Luke 18:25

How did God speak to you through Sunday's worship and the message of Luke 18:25?

POINT: To GO in, you 've got to let GO (and LET God)

1. How difficult is it to thread a needle eye? Can you think of some everyday situations where, "Thread the needle," is used? How?

In v24, Jesus speaks of Palestine's largest animal trying to get through its smallest opening—the eye of a needle. Why is wealth an 'impossible' obstacle to trusting God?

2. How rich is a rich person? What formula do you think Jesus would use to give an answer?

3. Discuss the Point: "To GO in, you 've got to let GO." Giving your heart to wealth instead of God is just one example. What are some others? Why's it so hard to trust God in their place?
4. Read v27. What's Jesus saying to Peter's question, "Who then can be saved?" Consider this: only God can change the selfishness that keeps a person from entering the Kingdom of God.
5. Read v29-30 and discuss the rewards that come with entering the Kingdom. In your experience, are these rewards real to you? How?
